Description

Paracril BJ is a copolymer of butadiene and acrylonitrile, hot polymerized with a non-staining stabilizer.

Packing

This product is commercialized in 25 Kg/Bale (55 Lb. /Bale) - 1,000 Kg/Skid - Net (2,200 Lb. /Skid.) rectangular bales individually wrapped in low melting point polyethylene film. Tolerance in all bale and packaging weights ± 1 percent.

Uses

Paracril BJ offers excellent balance of low temperature flexibility with oil resistance, and good processing characteristics. It is recommended for automotive products, seals, hoses, O-rings, packing's, adhesives, sponge and printing blankets.

Storage

Store in a dry and ventilated area where it will not be exposed to direct sunlight, extreme temperatures or sources of ignition.
